QUAICH RULES 2025

RULES FOR SHEPHERD QUAICH (revised 11.24)

TEAMS

- (a) As many teams as desired may be entered from any one club. Each team to consist of 2 couples. Entries close the last Sunday of April.
- (b) Players may represent one team from one club only.
- (C) Other players may be used in subsequent rounds provided they have not played for any other teams (including another team from the same club).
- (d) Players with handicap 36 and under may play.
- (e) The competition is redrawn after each round, with the first drawn team having home advantage. CAPTAIN
- (a) Each team shall have a named Captain.
- (b) The Captain of the challenging (top-named) team must contact the opposing Captain to arrange time of play etc.
- (C) Captains of opposing teams MUST exchange written order of their team BEFORE the match. **DATES**

Matches are to be played the second weekend of the month. If this is not possible, a mutually agreed date before the second weekend of the month can be used. Generally, given the number of teams normally entering, matches will begin in June, with the final being in September.

Matches must be played on the given dates at the 'HOME' course of the challenger in each tie. If for any reason the 'HOME' course is not available, the tie to be played on the other course.

METHOD-of-PLAY

The method of play shall be 'Foursomes' on handicap (half of difference between aggregate handicaps) and the result determined by joint result over 18 holes. In the event of a tie, the foursomes shall proceed one hole at a time (strokes used if any) until one team wins overall.

UNPLAYABLE COURSE

If the course is, or becomes unplayable, the match should be suspended.

Should a match be suspended, it is to be resumed that day at the point of play.

ABANDONED MATCH

If for any reason the match cannot be resumed on the same day and has to be abandoned, the whole match should be played as soon as suits both teams.

GREEN FEES

Any green fees involved shall be shared by both teams.

RESULTS

The Captains of the WINNING TEAMS should notify the County Captain <u>captain@angusladiesgolf.org</u> of the result **as soon as possible**.

FINAL

The Final shall be played the second weekend of September on a neutral course (arranged by the County Secretary). Should courtesy not be granted, the County plus the two teams involved will share the green fees.
